

The Small Grants Application Form

The on-line small grants application form will require the following information. Please have this information available prior to starting the form:

- 1. Name of person submitting proposal (must be an adult over 21) and that person's phone number
- 2. A purpose for your project (2 sentences max: start with type of project [1. Academic development or life skills; 2. Community service; or 3. Semester of Service])
- 3. The project's educational goals (Visit http://www.gotoservicelearning.org for helpful information.)
- 4. A description of the project (who, when, where, how, and why)
- 5. An estimate of the number of youth and an estimate of the number of adults that will participate
- 6. Which (one or more) of the five goals of America's Promise will your project support
- 7. How the grant money will be used (breakout of associated costs)
- 8. The name of your organization, an approving official from the organization, and that person's title and contact information (cannot be the same as #1 above)
- 9. Amount (\$) of grant request
- 10. Start date and end date for your project
- 11. A date for a major event of your project
- 12. Total cost of your project
- 13. Supervisor of the project and their contact information (phone & e-mail)
